

# What's new in RadarOpus v3.1

*New implementations and improvements of version 3.1 as compared to 3.0*

RadarOpus **3.1** will be delivered as a **Full Installer** - as an ISO and as a zip file.

This version offers the following new features as compared to 3.0:

## SUMMARY

- **Synthesis Adonis** released including updated database - providing links between Materia Medica and Repertory.
- **Show/ Hide Families-as-remedies**
  - New option to highlight, sort alphabetically or arrange at the top/bottom of each symptom.
  - This allows each Homeopath to choose their preference for working with families – providing options to make families more or less visible and separated or integrated within the list of remedies.
- **Views** - New and updated views for Synthesis Adonis.
  - E.G. New Views
    - Families only. Remedies only. Clinical confirmation only.
    - All other views have been updated in-line with our expanding catalog of authors and references.
- **Updated Veterinary** edition for Synthesis Adonis
  - New additions specific to veterinary practice of Homeopathy.
  - New icon(s) to highlight whether Human/ Veterinary version is used.
- **New Chapter Icons** for Synthesis Adonis
- **Backup/ Restore/ Installation** – adjusted procedures
  - **Personal Additions** are now reimported via logfile. Before they were included in the Backup/ Restore.
- **Fixes**
  - **Broken links** in Concepts repertories have been fixed.  
E.G. Acute disease (Schroyens F.)
  - **Slower speed** with Tags enabled in Navigation/ Search modules. Fixed
  - **Backup** – solved a problem where RadarOpus sometimes created a very large Backup.
  - **Restore** - solved a problem where the Restore could take a long time.
  - **Favorite Keynotes** now display the author name as well as the document title.

## WHAT'S NEW IN RADAROPUS 3.1

- Fixed a problem on Windows computers where the Print layout was not optimal when a custom zoom setting was applied.
- Fixed a problem where Boericke's Materia Medica would cause RadarOpus to crash when selected as a Favorite Keynote.
