

What's new in RadarOpus v3.1

New implementations and improvements of version 3.1 as compared to 3.0

RadarOpus **3.1** will be delivered as a **Full Installer** - as an ISO and as a zip file.

This version offers the following new features as compared to 3.0:

SUMMARY

- **Synthesis Adonis** released including updated database - providing links between Materia Medica and Repertory.
- **Show/ Hide Families-as-remedies**
 - New option to highlight, sort alphabetically or arrange at the top/bottom of each symptom.
 - This allows each Homeopath to choose their preference for working with families – providing options to make families more or less visible and separated or integrated within the list of remedies.
- **Views** - New and updated views for Synthesis Adonis.
 - E.G. New Views
 - Families only. Remedies only. Clinical confirmation only.
 - All other views have been updated in-line with our expanding catalog of authors and references.
- **Updated Veterinary** edition for Synthesis Adonis
 - New additions specific to veterinary practice of Homeopathy.
 - New icon(s) to highlight whether Human/ Veterinary version is used.
- **New Chapter Icons** for Synthesis Adonis
- **Backup/ Restore/ Installation** – adjusted procedures
 - **Personal Additions** are now reimported via logfile. Before they were included in the Backup / Restore.
- **Fixes**
 - **Broken links** in Concepts repertories have been fixed.
E.G. Acute disease (Schroyens F.)
 - **Slower speed** with Tags enabled in Navigation/ Search modules. Fixed
 - **Backup** – solved a problem where RadarOpus sometimes created a very large Backup.
 - **Restore** - solved a problem where the Restore could take a long time.
 - **Favorite Keynotes** now display the author name as well as the document title.

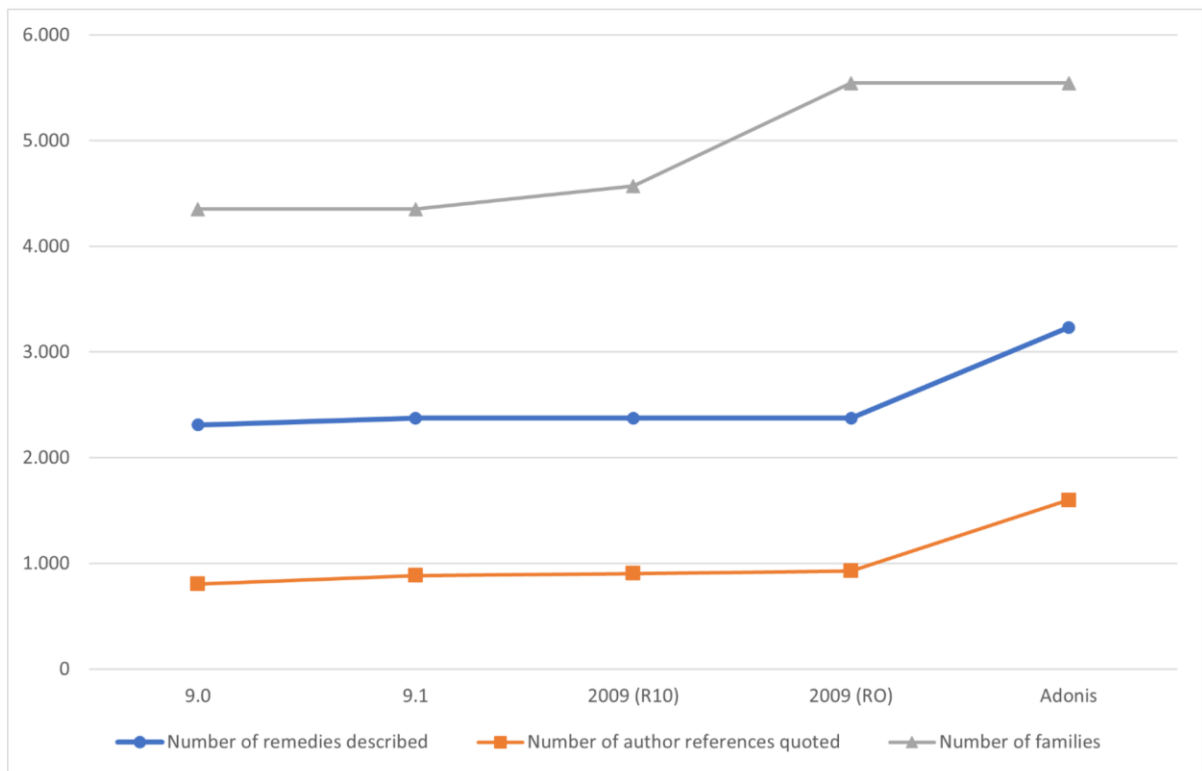
- Fixed a problem on Windows computers where the Print layout was not optimal when a custom zoom setting was applied.

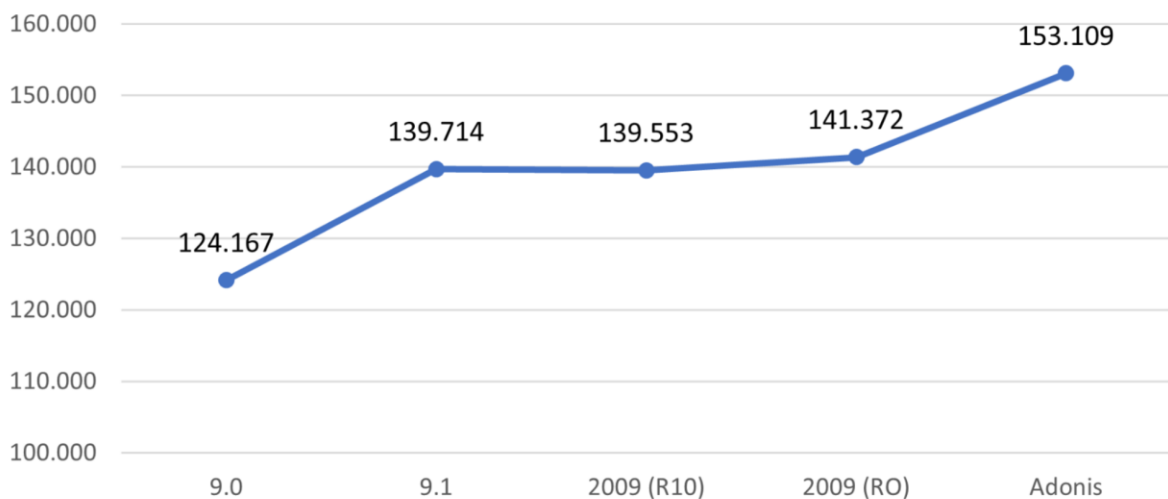

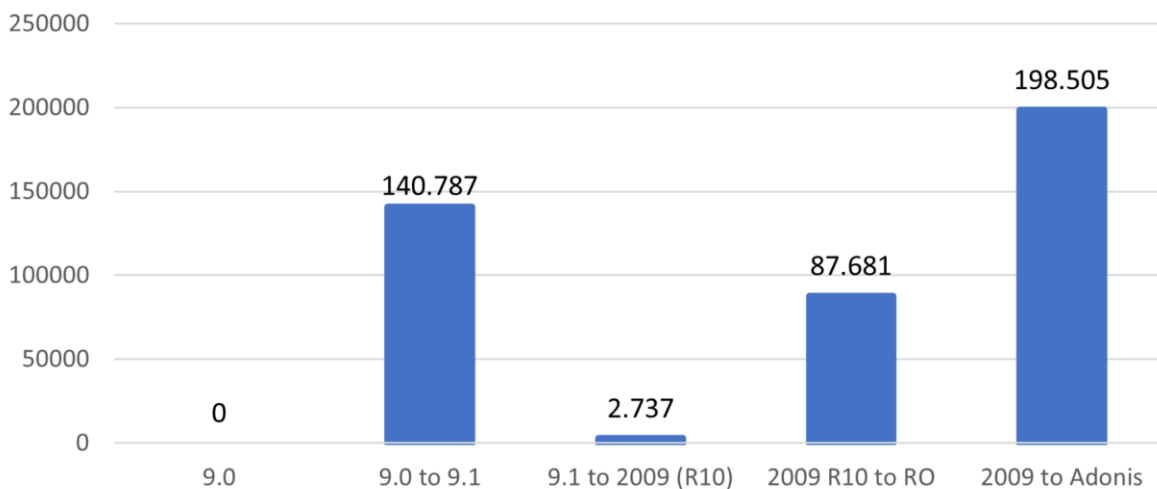

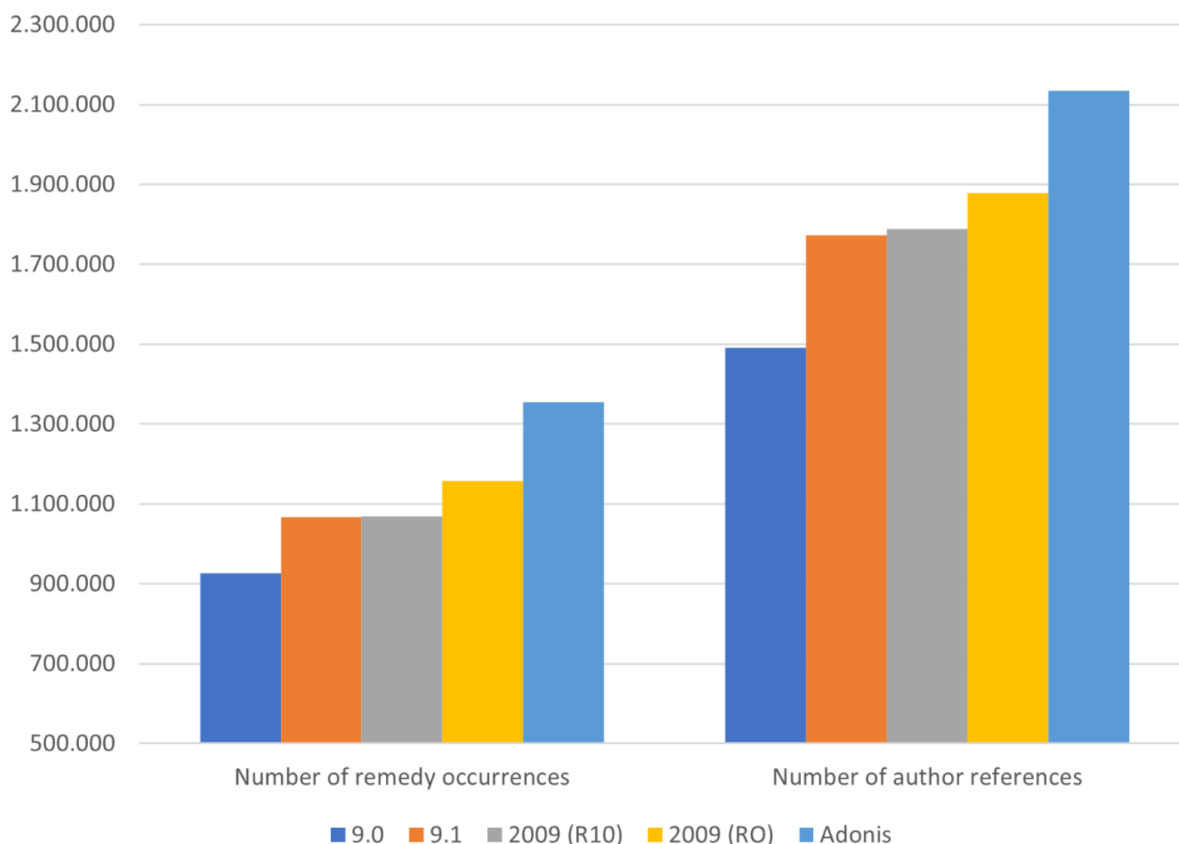
Number of symptoms with remedies



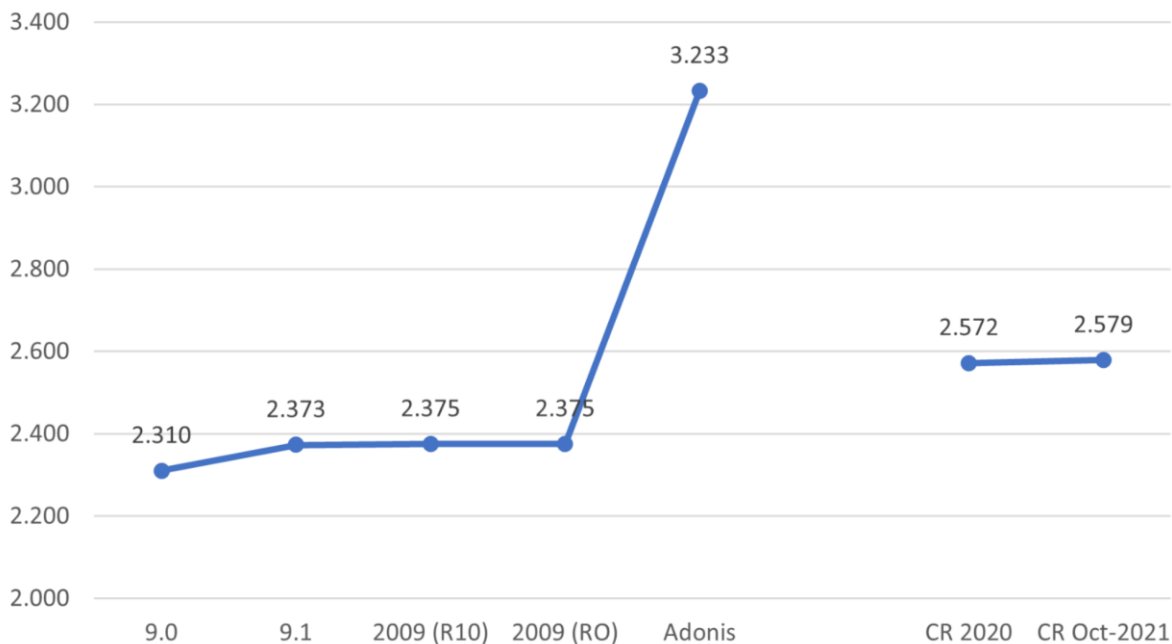
Number of remedy occurrences compared to previous version



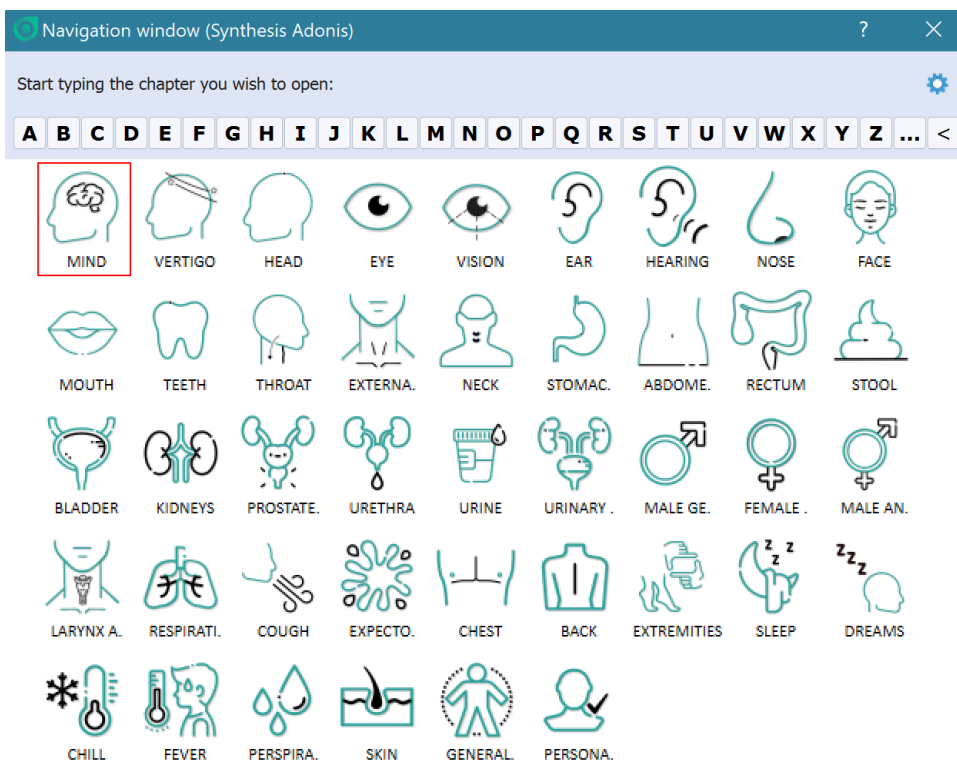

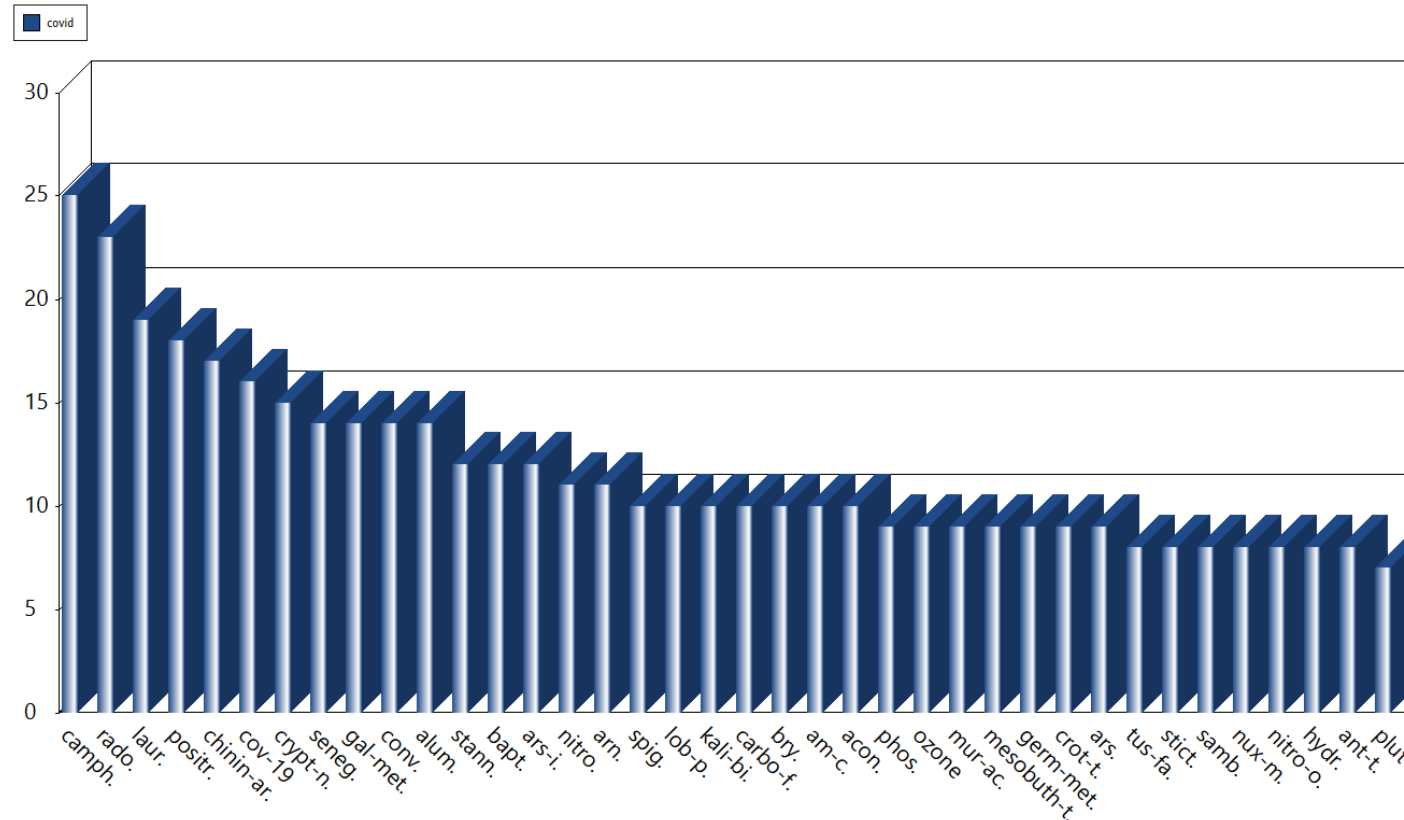

Situation / characterization

To be a bore - to be tiresome, dull.

- A problem of engagement of attention, e.g you are prevented/ forced to/ unable to engage with a subject or task because of a suppressive agent (prescription drug, overbearing parent, irascible teacher).
- Situation might be when one is in a depression already - there is a lack of energy and motivation to be one's true self. If a problem is left to fester rather than allowing things to run their course, there is suppression of the vitality - ignoring the problem won't make it go away.
- Ennui may arise from depressive states as the individual has become stuck in a 'holding pattern' rather than embracing the opportunities life presents them.
- The perception of one's environment as dull, tedious, lacking stimulation is really a reflection of an inner state, where there is denial/ suppression of freedom of expression.
- It is the manner of 'looking' that makes a situation seem tedious. If there is impatience and a lot of mental noise, then it will be difficult to switch off, hence people are trying out lots of new experiences, trying to change their external environment to remedy their dysfunctional internal state.
- Daydreaming may be a passive way to avoid boredom - whilst also avoiding the 'world out there' they focus on the world 'in here' which might become very expansive in such attempts to wish-away ennui.

Opposite expression


- Fascination with life: seeing, participating and being present to enjoy all the subtleties of existence. There should never be a reason to be bored!


New rubrics in contemporary language have been added

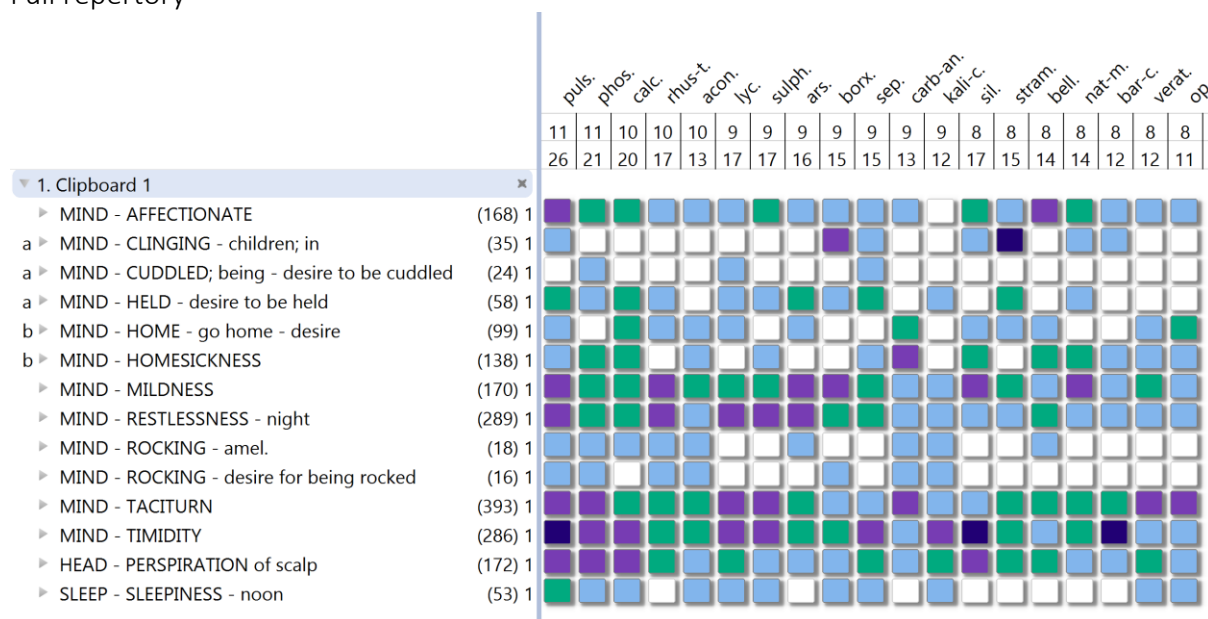

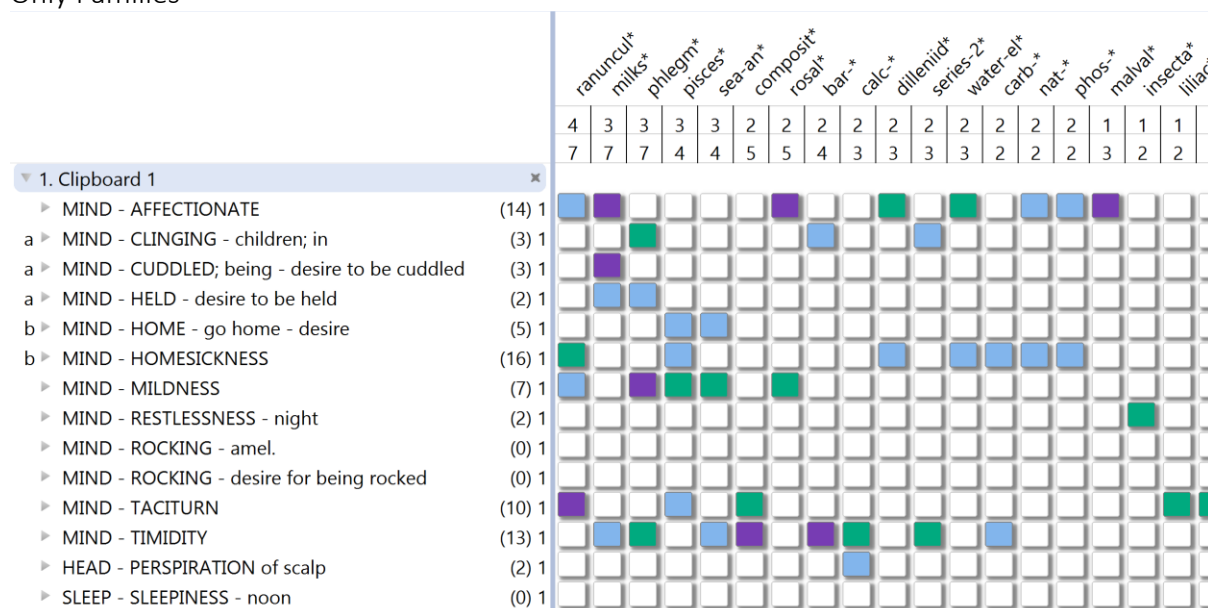

- All families end with an asterisk (e.g. solanac*), so they can be easily recognized.
- There is the option to highlight families
- And options to sort them
 - Alphabetically (= integrated in the same list as remedies)
 - Top of symptom (= above remedies)
 - Bottom of symptom (= below remedies)

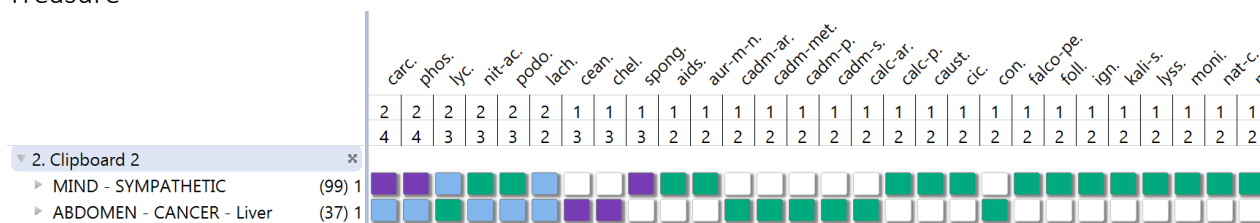
